

INVITATION TO BIDDERS

The Cayuga County Soil and Water Conservation District, Cayuga County, New York, will receive sealed bids for the Green Hill Dairy, Inc. Bunk Silo Relocation and Leachate Collection System which consists of the relocation of a bunk silo, including construction of a new 37,547 square foot bunk silo and aprons, including earthwork, concrete and drainage; 15,600 square foot access road; 18,891 square foot crushed stone equipment staging area; and bunk leachate system improvements, including a level lip spreader, leachate pump, new 100' x 300' vegetated treatment area and other improvements to existing vegetated treatment area at the site on Mosher Road, in the Town of Scipio.

The specifications and bid documents are available by contacting the Cayuga County Soil and Water Conservation District at 315-252-4171, ext. 4. Copies of the documents can be obtained for a fee of \$10.00 if e-mailed or picked up at the office and/or delivered at the site showing. They are \$50.00 plus shipping, if they are mailed. Fees are non-refundable. Those receiving electronic copies are responsible for verifying receipt of all documents.

A site showing will be held on Wednesday, June 8, 2022 at 9:00 AM at the site location on Mosher Road, in the Town of Scipio. Contractors must attend the site showing for their bids to be accepted.

Bid proposals will be received until 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, June 29, 2022 at the office of the Cayuga County Soil and Water Conservation District, 7413 County House Road, Auburn, NY 13021. Bids will be opened at 9:30 A.M. on the bid due date. Bids will not be accepted any later than 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, June 29, 2022. Facsimile bids will not be accepted. E-mailed bids will be accepted. However, the Cayuga County Soil and Water Conservation District is not responsible for the guaranteed receipt of any bids submitted electronically. It is the sole responsibility of the bidder to ensure that the bid is received by the bid deadline and in the proper format.

The District Board reserves the right to waive any information in bids and to reject any/or all bids if it is in the public interest to do so.
